

CQ Press, sponsor of the award, will present the \$1,000 award and plaque to Eaton during the 2012 ALA Annual Conference in Anaheim, Calif.


“John Eaton’s accomplishments to service and scholarship in law librarianship are exemplary,” said award Chair Nadine R. Hoffman, natural resources, energy and environmental law librarian at the University of Calgary. “In particular, we recognize his dedication to the Canadian Association of Law Libraries/Association Canadienne des Bibliothèques de Droit (CALL/ACBD) in a variety of capacities, including president.
