freedom of religion, privacy, etc, the right not to be criminalized has proved to be a rather powerful justice constraint in the U.S. Yet the general right not to be criminalized has not been fully embraced in either the U.S. or Europe, although it does exist. This volume lays out the legal foundations of that right and the criteria for determining when the state might override it. This book will be of interest to researchers in the areas of legal philosophy, criminal law, constitutional law, and criminology.

Seek pro bono costs



UNLOCK FUNDS FOR JUSTICE

Pro bono costs are like an ordinary award of costs, but where a party had free legal representation. If your client wins, the losing side need not benefit from your free work; you can seek a pro bono costs order against them. This means that the other side now also has a costs risk to consider.

The County Court, High Court and Court of Appeal Civil Division can award pro bono costs broadly where they would award normal costs. The costs cover any period when free representation was provided, and even if only one of the lawyers acted for free (i.e. normal costs can also be sought for the fee-paid work). The amount is based on what a paying client would recover.

The legislation requires the costs to be paid to the prescribed charity, the Access to Justice Foundation, set up by the Bar Council, Law Society, ILEX and Advice Services Alliance.

Quick guide for court hearings

1. **File & serve a statement of costs** using court form N260. This shows what free work you did, and what it would have cost a paying client at your normal rates.
2. **Ask for a pro bono costs order** under s.194 Legal Services Act 2007 and CPR 44.3C. The procedure is the same as obtaining a normal costs order. Wherever possible **seek summary assessment**. Costs can also be agreed.
3. **Suggest this wording** for the order:
The [party] must pay costs for pro bono representation to The Access to Justice Foundation (PO Box 64162, London WC1A 9AN), [summarily assessed at £____] [or] [to be assessed on the standard / indemnity basis if not agreed].
4. **Tell the Foundation** when you secure pro bono costs (costs@ATJF.org.uk).
5. The Foundation then distributes the money to agencies and projects that give free legal help to those in need.



It considers general common law characteristics of watercourses and coastal waters, natural and acquired rights of water, artificial watercourses and underground water, ferries, bridges and fisheries. It also covers water regulation and surveys statutes concerned with water management responsibilities, water resources, water pollution, flood defence, and fisheries. The new edition provides full coverage of the principles of common law on water rights and the statutory requirements relating to water management, water quality, water quantity and recreation and conservation, and considers in detail developments under the Environment Act

1995, the Water Act 2003, the Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009, the Flood and Water Management Act 2010, the Environmental Permitting Regulations 2010, and the Aquatic Animal Health Regulations 2009. Recent cases on water rights, fisheries and conservation are discussed, including *Lovett v Fairclough* on the acquisition of fishing rights, the Cambridge Water case on groundwater pollution, and cases relating to the protection of habitats culminating in the Wightlink case. 
This book examines the history, principles, and practice of awarding compensation and restitution in investor-State arbitration disputes, which are initiated under investment treaties. The principles discussed may be applied to all international law cases where damage to property is an issue. The book starts by tracing the roots of the applicable international legal principles to Roman law, and from there follows their evolution through the European law of extra-contractual liability and eventually through the *Chorzów Factory* case to principles of compensation and restitution in the modern law of international investment. The greater part of the book is then dedicated to examination of the modern application of these principles, focusing on the jurisprudence of international tribunals under various arbitral rules such

as ICSID and UNCITRAL Rules. Monetary compensation as the prevalent form of remedy sought and awarded in investor-State disputes is discussed in more detail, including topics such as the amount of compensation for damage resulting from breach of investment treaties or for lawful expropriation of foreign investor's property, a brief overview of valuation methods, supplementary compensation for moral damages, interest, costs, and currency fluctuations as well as various principles that may limit the amount of recoverable compensation, such as causation. A full chapter is dedicated to the discussion of the theory and practice of awarding restitution in investor-State disputes. The book also covers the general principle of reparation in international law as applied in investor-State arbitrations. The topics discussed cover all the theoretical as well as practical issues which may be raised in awarding compensation and restitution in investment treaty disputes between States and foreign investors.


The statutory provisions on drink-driving are set out in just fifteen sections of the Road Traffic Act 1988, and two from the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988, but there have been over 700 appeals to the Divisional Court on points of law since the Acts came into force. The result is a body of law which is technical and complex, covering a wide array of matters.

The Drink-Drive Offences provides a practical, comprehensive, accessible and up-to-date account of this broad and intriguing area of law. It traces the procedure from preliminary testing to penalties, taking the legislative provisions in sequence and explaining the effects of the case law. The routines for preliminary testing, and for requiring and analysing specimens of breath, blood or urine, are examined. This includes the recurring question of the reliability of the breath analysis instrument and the circumstances in which a blood or urine specimen may be required instead of a breath specimen. The constituents of the offences are explained, in chapters on the excess alcohol offences, the offences of being in charge, the offences of being unfit to drive, and causing death by careless driving when under the influence of drink or drugs. The statutory assumption that the level of alcohol at the time of the offence was no less than in the specimen receives special attention, along with the “hip flask” defence, where the motorist asserts that it was alcohol consumed after driving which accounts for being over the limit. A chapter is devoted to the offences of failing to co-operate with preliminary tests and failing to provide specimens, with full consideration of what constitutes a “reasonable excuse” for these purposes. Finally, the penalties are set out, including special reasons for not disqualifying.
